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Personal Safety

Hazards	Are there any hazardsor could hazards develop? Gloves?
What Happened	How did this happenwhat kind of injuries might be likelyis it now safe?
How many people need help	Is there just one personor several people who are injured or need assistance?
Helpers	Is there anyone nearby who can help youor call 9-1-1 and get an AED?

Assess ABC's

A - Airway	Is the airway clearis a Head-Tilt-Chin-Lift needed?
B - Breathing	Is the person breathing?Yes or NoAre they alive or dead?
C - Circulation	Do they appear to be bleeding?Are they Pale?Sweaty?Red?Bluish?

Call 9-1-1

Should you Call 9-1-1?	Err on the side of caution
	Send someone elsehave them report back and bring an AED if possible

Ongoing Assessment and Care

A Ainway	Keep the airway open
A - Airway	Roll them if needed
D. Droothing	Ensure they are breathing
B - Breathing	CPR if they stop breathing.
	Control major bleeding
C - Circulation	Treat for Shock

Assisting with Medication	

You can help someone with their medication if...

- It is safe to do so
- The person is responsive and has expressed a desire for help with the medication

Secondary Survey

Interview	
S	Signs and Symptoms – what is hurting or causing discomfort
Α	Allergies – are you allergic to anythingand have you been recently exposed
М	Medications – do you take medicationhave you taken too muchtoo littlenew ones recently?
Р	Previous Medical History – eg: DiabetesAsthmaAngina?
L	Last Meal – what and when did you last eat or drinkis that normal for you?
E	Events Leading Up To – what were you doing when the pain or discomfort started?

Vital Signs	
Level of Consciousness	Do they appear more or less conscious than earlier?
Breathing	Does their breathing appear better or worse than earlier?
Skin	How does their skin look and feel?

Injury Check	
Hands-On Examination	Physically check and feel for injuries (Unresponsive patients)
Hands-Off Examination	Thoroughly look at and feel any areas of pain or discomfort (Responsive patients)
